NEGOTIATIONS SUSPENDED IN 1996 NEW DRAFT AGREEMENT PRESENTED BY POLAND IN DECEMBER 2004

18 SEPTEMBER 2006 RUSSIA PRESENTS ITS PROPOSAL THROUGH POLISH EMBASSY IN MOSCOW

NEGOTIATIONS TO BEGIN IN TIME CONVENIENT FOR BOTH SIDES

- AGREEMENT ON CO-OPERATION IN COMBATING OIL AND OTHER DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES POLLUTIONS IN THE AREA OF THE BALTIC SEA AND THE VISTULA BAY
 (THE AGREEMENT IN THE COURSE OF CONSULTATIONS. NEXT EXPERT MEETING DUE TO TAKE PLACE IN MOSCOW IN NOVEMBER 2006)
