General Information

Transfer (to hotel)

HAMBURG

Arriving at **Hamburg Airport**:

- by taxi (approx. 25 €)
- by public transport: Take the bus-shuttle Airport Express to the train station Ohlsdorf. From here the tramway S 1 in direction “Wedel / Blankenese” will take you to Landungsbrücken. Exit the station by following the signs Landungsbrücken. On leaving the station you will see the hotel on the right hand side. A flight of stairs just below the building will take you upstairs to the hotel.

- by taxi (approx. 15 €)
- by public transport: tramway S1 in direction “Wedel / Blankenese” or tramway S3 in direction “Pinneberg”. Get off at “Landungsbrücken”. See above (Arriving at airport).
